

Painting Ceramic Christmas Ornaments with Lordy Dordie using

Pebeo Porcelain 150 paint



Difficulty: Easy

Pebeo Porcelaine 150 Decorative Paints are specialty paints that can be applied to porcelain, earthenware, and ceramics to mimic the look of glazed ceramics without the need for a kiln. To cure the paint onto the surface, bake in a conventional oven for 30-35 minutes at 150°C. Once dry, the paint colour is permanent, microwave-safe, and dishwasher-safe.

Pebeo Porcelaine 150 Decorative Paints can be blended to create a wider colour palette and come in a gloss finish. They are also compatible with Pebeo Porcelaine 150 Markers for fine detail work.

Before using, stir the contents of the paint pot with a craft stick to ensure the paint is fully mixed, as settling can occur. The paint can be applied with a brush, sponge, stencil, or stamp. Clean your tools with soap and warm water after use.

Materials

- Ceramic Round and Star Christmas Ornaments (purchased from Spotlight)
- Pebeo Porcelaine 150 Paints of your choice
- Your favourite paint brushes in various sizes
- A jar of water for cleaning brushes
- Rags or paper towels

Process:

Paint your desired Christmas design directly onto the Ceramic Ornaments. I love using strong colours and painting florals and abstracts. Once you have finished painting your Ornament, leave to dry. Clean brushes with soap and water.

- **Drying Time:** Let your ornaments dry for at least 24 hours to ensure the paint is fully dry before baking.
- **Baking Time:** 35 minutes Place the ornaments in a cold oven. Once the temperature reaches 150°C, bake for 30-35 minutes. The paint will take on a glazed, enamel-like finish. Allow the ornaments to cool slowly in the oven before removing them.
