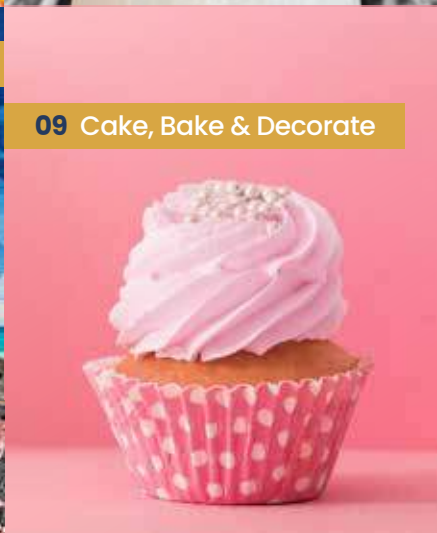

Next Level Knitting with Jake



Learn How to Knit the City

Discover the mesmerising world of architectural knitting with Australian artist and knitting designer, Jake Henzler.

Better known to global craft communities as 'Boy Knits World', Jake has been practising and exhibiting work internationally since 2006. Comprising mainly yarn and needlecraft techniques, his work ranges from knitted cityscape and landscape blankets to heirloom motifs and original characters. Recognisable influences include folk art traditions and popular culture, with a focus on elements of collectability, reproducibility and practical pattern-making. Jake's most well-known works use a number of knitted colourwork techniques to translate historic

building facades into soft, tactile, and highly detailed knitted objects.

In Jake's workshop sessions, you can learn all of the colourwork techniques needed to knit block patterns from Knit the City, including twist placement, carrying floats, next-row trapping and how to troubleshoot any errors. The workshop will include row-by-row guided knitting of one block from either Sydney or London, setting each participant up to begin their own project. All skill levels from beginner to expert are welcome.

As a feature artist at this year's show, Jake will be exhibiting many of his works and signing copies of his newly released book 'Knit the City' throughout the week.

Quilts hanging in the Queensland Quilt Show showcase the talents of individual members, affiliated groups and special interest groups. Featured exhibits include the Fabric Challenge, Modern Challenge and State of the Art (SOTA) quilts, alongside a range of special displays.

This is one of Australia's largest quilt shows, with over 220 quilts entered for judging and over 600 in total on display, with a prize pool of over \$20,000. On the first day of the Fair, October 14 at 10:15am, the Queensland Quilt Show competition winners will be announced. This year's theme, Curves, inspired

quilters to showcase their creativity, craftsmanship and innovative design.

Inspirational Colour

Rainbow Stash Series: Hero Colour Challenge

Featuring at the Brisbane Craft & Quilt Fair, the Rainbow Stash Series celebrates a global creative collaboration that brought together makers from New Zealand, the USA, Switzerland, Australia and beyond through a shared exploration of colour.

Each month, a single colour was selected live on Zoom and paired with a randomly chosen word prompt. Every participant worked with the same colour and the same

word, using the chosen hue as the dominant “hero” of their piece while interpreting the prompt through textile techniques, surface design, stitch and personal storytelling.

The result is a remarkable collection of more than 280 original 10-inch-square textile artworks, each one distinct yet connected through a shared beginning, making it a must-see feature of the Brisbane Craft & Quilt Fair.



The 100+ Hearts Project

On display at the Brisbane Craft & Quilt Fair, the 100+ Hearts Project celebrates an international collection of quilt blocks created to raise awareness of women's heart health through creative expression.

Participants were invited to create a quilt block in honour of a woman affected by heart disease and to share her story. Each block represents a personal tribute, reflecting experiences of courage, resilience, remembrance and hope.

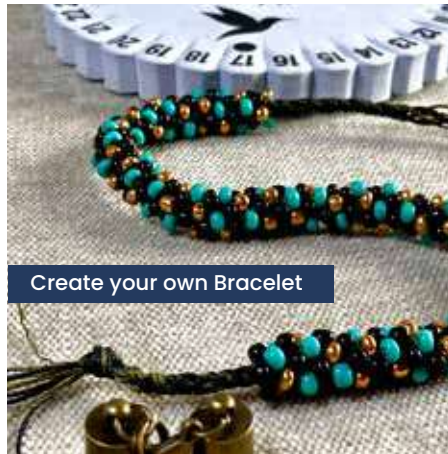

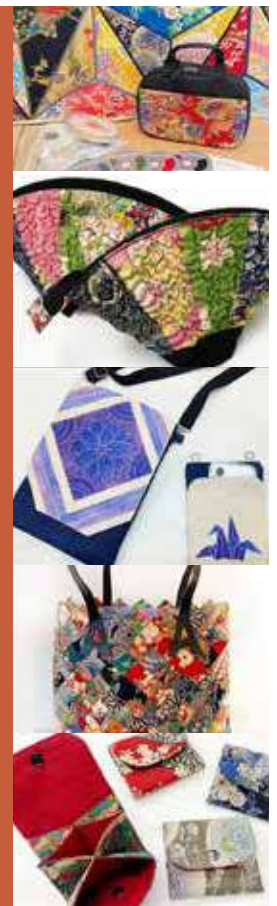
